4. Qualifications requirements include:
- (i) Bids may be supplied by manufacturer or dealer who has previous experience at least 5 years in supply of similar offer.
 - (ii) Bidders should possess the Certificate of Business Registration issued by the Governmental Authority in the relevant field.
 - (iii) Bidders should submit manufacturer's authorization form in the prescribed form.
 - (iv) If the bid is from the manufacturer directly, clearly state the availability of the local agents in Sri Lanka for the supply of spare parts and after sales services and the maintenance of the items offers in the bid.
 - (v) In the event of an Agent submits bids on behalf of more than one Manufacturer, unless each bid is accompanied by a separate bid security and authorization from the respective Manufacturer, all such bids will be rejected.
 - (vi) Registration with National Medicine Regulatory Authority for items listed in Annex A.
5. The margin of preference for locally produced goods shall not be applied. Additional details are provided in the Bidding Documents.
6. A complete set of Bidding Documents in English language may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Rupees 2,500/=. The documents may be purchased until one day before the deadline for submission of bids as given in paragraph 6 below.
7. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **02.30 p.m. on 20th August, 2018**. Late bids will not be accepted. Bids will be opened immediately thereafter in the presence of the bidders or their representatives who attend in person. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid-Security as specified in BDS.
